
TRAVEL TO LUXOR AND ASWAN






The pearl of Egypt's Mediterranean coast, Alexandria was founded by Alexander the Great in 332 BC and grew to become one of the most influential capitals of the ancient world, leading in the arts and sciences. Once governed by Cleopatra, Alexandria was the backdrop for her love affairs with Julius Caesar and Mark Antony. Blessed by cooling sea breezes and white-sand beaches, Alexandria remains one of the Middle East's most iconic cities to visit.

Four Seasons is located in the seaside enclave of San Stefano, often called Alexandria's Riviera – an area which gained renown in the 1960s and '70s as a playground for royals, celebrities, movie stars and café society. With a rich cultural heritage, Alexandria today is Egypt's second largest city, tempting with ancient landmarks, modern sophistication and beachside relaxation.



Visit the Roman Amphitheatre and the Citadel of Qaitbay, built on the site of Pharos Lighthouse, known as one of the seven wonders of the ancient world.

PLAN A NIGHT AT THE THEATRE

CHECK OUT A LEGENDARY LIBRARY

Built in the 3rd century BC, the Great Library of Alexandria flourished as a centre for knowledge and education before it was mysteriously destroyed centuries later. In 2002, the library was reborn as Bibliotheca Alexandrina, re-establishing the city's reputation as one of the world's major cultural centres. The complex includes four museums, 15 permanent art galleries and a planetarium.

SEE THE BEST OF THE MUSEUMS

DELVE INTO RELIGIOUS HISTORY Explore religious history first-hand in Alexandria. The oldest church in Africa, Saint Mark's Coptic Orthodox Cathedral was founded by Saint Mark in AD 42 and was the first to introduce Christianity to Alexandria. The grandscale Al Mursi Abu Al Abbas Mosque features four great domes, arabesque designs and a tall minaret. There's also the Synagogue, one of the most beautiful and oldest temples, with origins from 1354, along with Saint Catherine's Cathedral and the Cathedral of Evangelismos, built in 1847.






CHARTER YOUR OWN YACHT

Our Dive Centre is home to three large luxury yachts, available for charter. Spend a day cruising the azure waters of the Red Sea, sunbathing, diving and swimming with dolphins, while Four Seasons takes care of all the catering and service, including sunset toasts. It's the perfect way to celebrate a special family gathering or to create a romantic escape for two.

SNORKEL AT THE HOUSE REEFS

Just off the shoreline at Four Seasons, our two pristine house reefs feature stunning corals and brightly coloured reef fish – accessed easily from our jetties. The reef provides an ideal training site for children's snorkelling courses and Trimix Diver training. Let us plan a full- or half-day snorkelling excursion along the coast or farther offshore. Equipment is also available for parasailing, sea kayaking and stand-up paddleboarding and more.



EXPLORE MYSTERIOUS SHIPWRECKS

Our Four Seasons team can arrange guided dives to impressive wrecks, immersed in crystal-clear waters. You'll discover the Dunraven, a British steamship sunk in 1896, the Kormoran, a wrecked merchant vessel, as well as the SS Thistlegorm, considered one of the world's top 10 shipwreck diving sites. The ship was sunk in World War II and was rediscovered in the 1950s. It's now a lively haven for tuna, sea turtles, batfish and moray eels.

DIVE INTO DARKNESS

Night diving in the Red Sea promises a one-of-a-kind adventure. Even without lights, divers can see down to a depth of 10 metres (33 feet), just by the light of the full moon. There's plenty of activity at nearby sites, and on most nights, divers can see the bioluminescence of tiny particles of glowing plankton.





EXPLORE THE CITY CENTRE

Plan a stroll through the Old Market to soak up authentic Bedouin culture. Narrow streets and alleyways are flanked with shops selling Egyptian jewellery, clothing, rugs, leather goods, saffron and cinnamon. The massive Al Sahaba Mosque is a masterpiece of design with its soaring minarets and stunning domed ceiling. Also fascinating is the Sharm El Sheikh Museum, sharing the history of Egyptian civilization. In the evening, the Alf Leila Wa Leila Show features traditional Egyptian dances, set against a backdrop of magnificent architecture.

VIEW THE HEAVENLY CATHEDRAL

Voted one of the world's 10 most beautiful churches in 2010, when it was completed, this hilltop Coptic church dominates the skyline with its elegant architecture and twin rectangular towers. Step inside to view the tall stained-glass windows and the elaborately painted ceiling and walls, lavishly illustrated with stories from the Bible and the lives of the saints. It took a team of 19 people two years to paint the frescoes and murals.





JOURNEY INTO BIBLICAL HISTORY

Witness sunrise over Saint Catherine
Monastery, built at the spot where God is said
to have appeared to Moses in the Burning
Bush. This UNESCO World Heritage site is
the oldest continuously inhabited Christian
monastery, established in AD 565. You'll hike
up Mount Moses for a panoramic sunrise
view of the monastery and the glittering Red
Sea. Afterwards, enjoy a thoughtful breakfast
prepared by our Four Seasons chefs. Ask






