POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Age Limit

The Kids For All Seasons Program welcomes children 5 to 12 years of age.

Registration

A parent or guardian is required to fill out a Release, Indemnification and Authorization Form (Registration Form) upon enrolling children into the program. All children attending Kids For All Seasons must be signed in and out each time they are dropped off and picked up from camp. We require the name of each person authorized to sign your child in or out of the program. You must notify Kids For All Seasons in advance if someone not listed on the authorization log will be signing your child out of the program.

Children's Personal Belongings

Your child is solely responsible for his or her personal belongings. Kids For All Seasons will not be held responsible for any lost or damaged items.

Child Participation

Your child must be able to follow along with all daily scheduled activities. If your child disrupts and cannot follow along with the scheduled activities, directions or rules, our program leader will contact you immediately to sign your child out of the program.

What To Bring

Please bring a swim suit if your child is an independent swimmer. Children should wear comfortable footwear and please apply sunscreen prior to arrival. A change of clothes is optional.

Kids For All Seasons Liability Insurance Coverage

The Resort does carry liability insurance, however, should your child suffer any injury loss or damage, you have agreed to indemnify, reimburse, defend and hold harmless the indemnities against any and all liability claims, costs, expenses (including attorney fees), damages, causes of action or demands of any kind which any or all of them may have to pay or become liable for in conjunction with, or arising out of your child's participation in the children's program or as a result of any decision taken under the authorization granted. All incidents are immediately reported to Four Seasons Resort Maui Security. Parents or guardian of the child will be notified. The Four Seasons Maui and Kids For All Seasons staff will not be held responsible for any incident if information has been falsified on a child's Release, Indemnification and Authorization Form.

The Kids For All Seasons Admission of Children with Disabilities
