

Enjoy exclusive access as an expert guide brings to life the past, present and future of New Orleans. Immersive exhibits highlight art, music and food. TALES OF THE FRENCH QUARTER

STROLL THROUGH HISTORY

A local history expert guides you on a fascinating walk through the narrow streets of the French Quarter, just a few minutes from Four Seasons. INSIDE THE VAULT

MUST-TRY FOOD TOUR

New Orleans is famous for food. There are so many signature dishes every visitor needs to try. In this essential outing, one of our Four Seasons chefs escorts your group on a walking tour of renowned restaurants and food shops. Stop to sample bite-size portions of the city's most iconic tastes – from gumbo and jambalaya to beignets, pralines, and king cakes. Everyone needs to bring their appetite!



LEGENDARY LIBATIONS

LIQUID HISTORY TOUR

Learn about the Prohibition era and our city's notorious speakeasies in this spirited walk through the French Quarter. Stop at various bars for sipping and storytelling, tasting cocktails invented in New Orleans, including the Hurricane, the French 75, the Vieux Carré, and the Ramos Gin Fizz. The tour climaxes at Sazerac House, showcasing the namesake cocktail and including its in-house rye distillery.

MOVE YA BRASS

MORNING FITNESS CLASS

Start the day with a fun, funky fitness session featuring a live jazz band. The Move Ya Brass Krewe teaches signature NOLA bounce moves in an amazing cardio workout. Their mission is to make fitness a happy, positive and healthy experience. Best of all: for every class you book, they donate a free class to members of the local community.

SECOND LINE PARADE

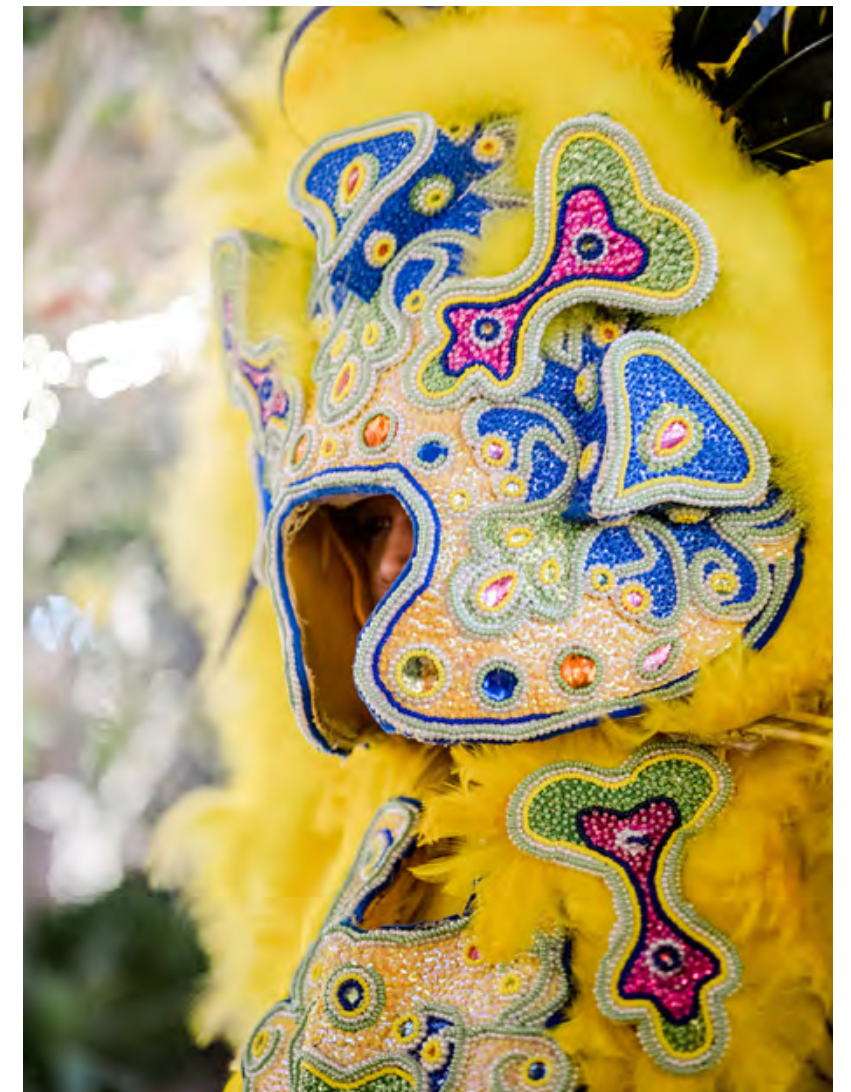
DANCE THROUGH THE STREETS

Picture a brass band leading a parade through the streets, as a dancing crowd waves handkerchiefs and umbrellas. The second line is a joyful part of local celebrations. JAZZ NIGHT

YOUR OWN PRIVATE CLUB

FISHING ON DA BAYOU

EARLY-MORNING ANGLING

Experience some of Louisiana's richest fishing grounds, deep in the bayous. Take a charter to the dock, where fishing boats are stocked with tackle and gear. A professional angler educates everyone on the techniques for catching speckled trout, redfish, flounder or bass, depending on the season. Your fish will then be cleaned and fried Louisiana-style for a delicious lunch.



GULF OYSTERS

HARVEST AND TASTING

Take a sea plane to the Gulf of Mexico for this early-morning oyster adventure, meeting a Four Seasons chef on board an oyster dredge boat. Get an up-close view of how oysters are harvested, then taste the freshest specimens straight from the sea. We'll supply champagne and Bloody Marys, along with all the oyster accoutrements. It's an epicurean experience like no other.

COASTAL CONSERVATION

JOURNEY INTO CAJUN COUNTRY

Join us for an exhilarating journey into the mystical wetlands of St. Bernard Parish – just a 40-minute drive from Four Seasons. Hop on a pontoon boat and glide into the depths of Cajun country. See exotic plants and wildlife, and hear tales of how Cajun folk coexist with their environment. Then relax over an authentic Louisiana seafood boil, served overlooking the bayou.

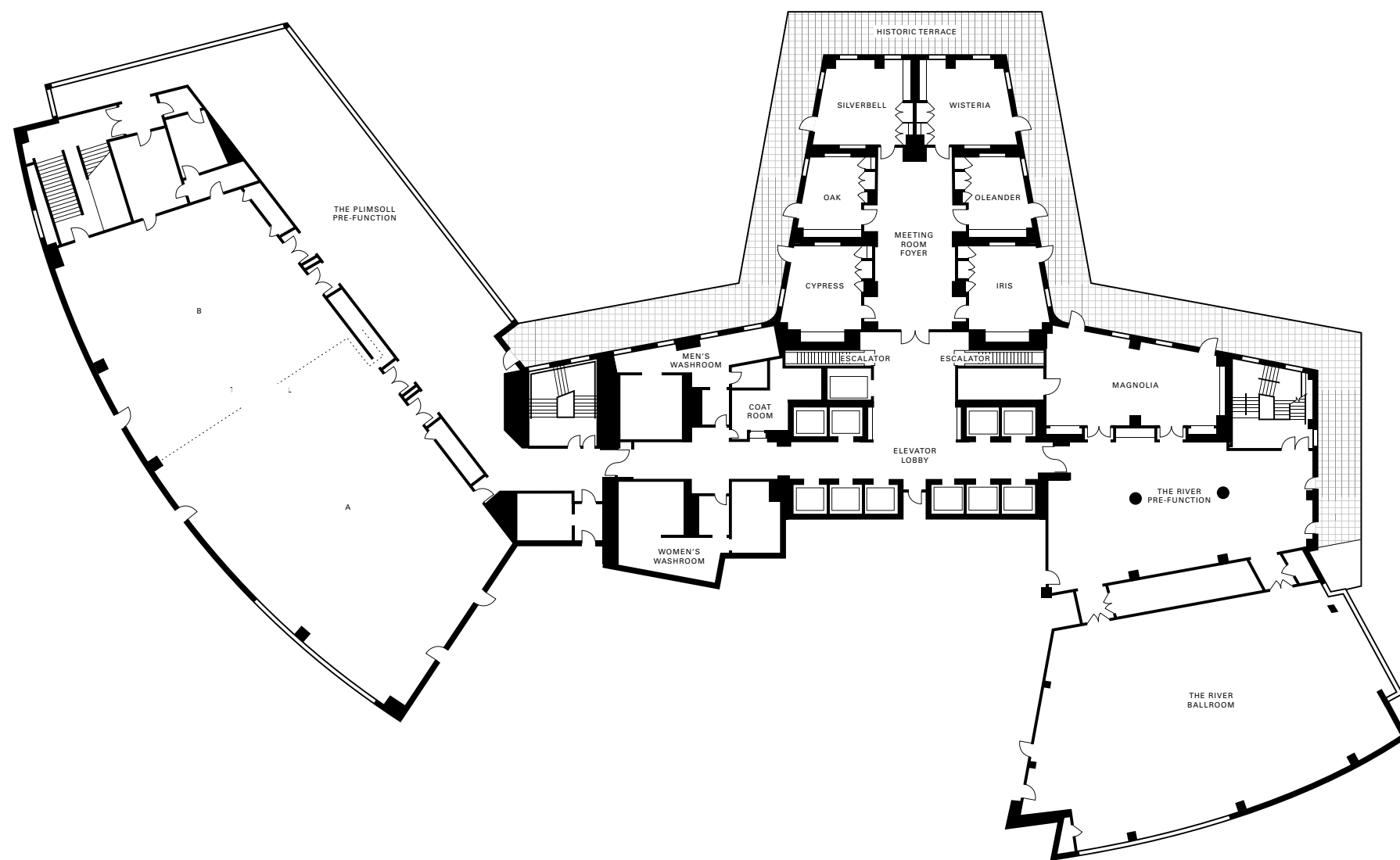

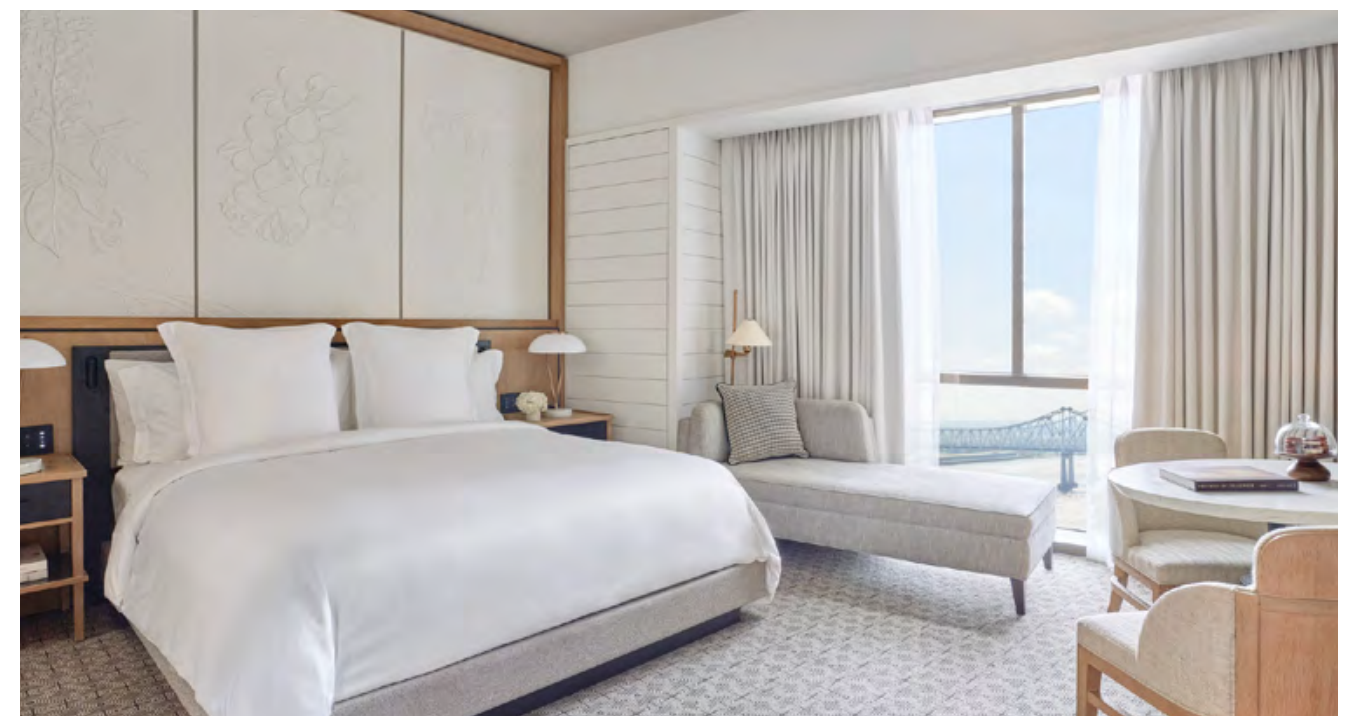
Guest Rooms and Suites

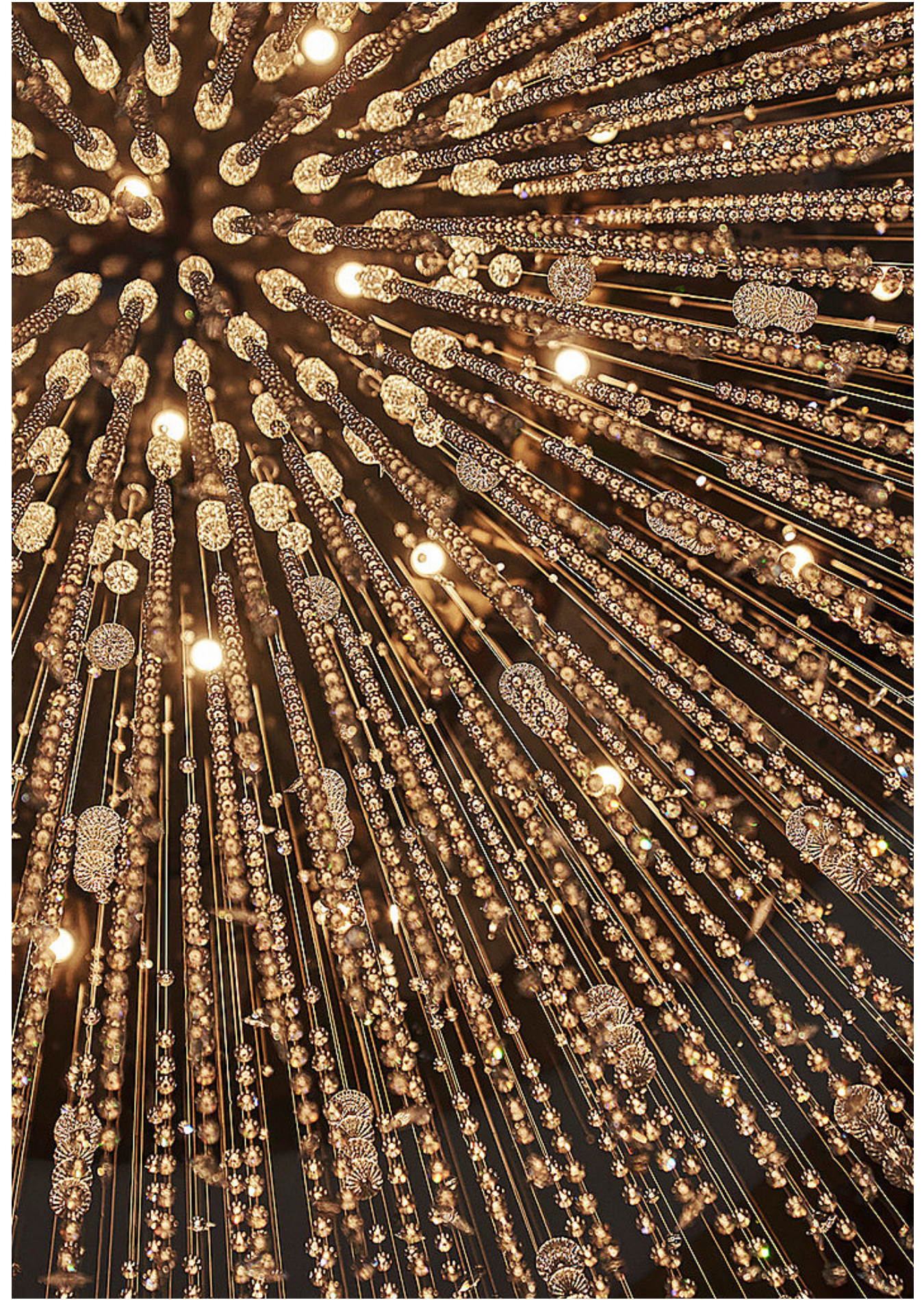

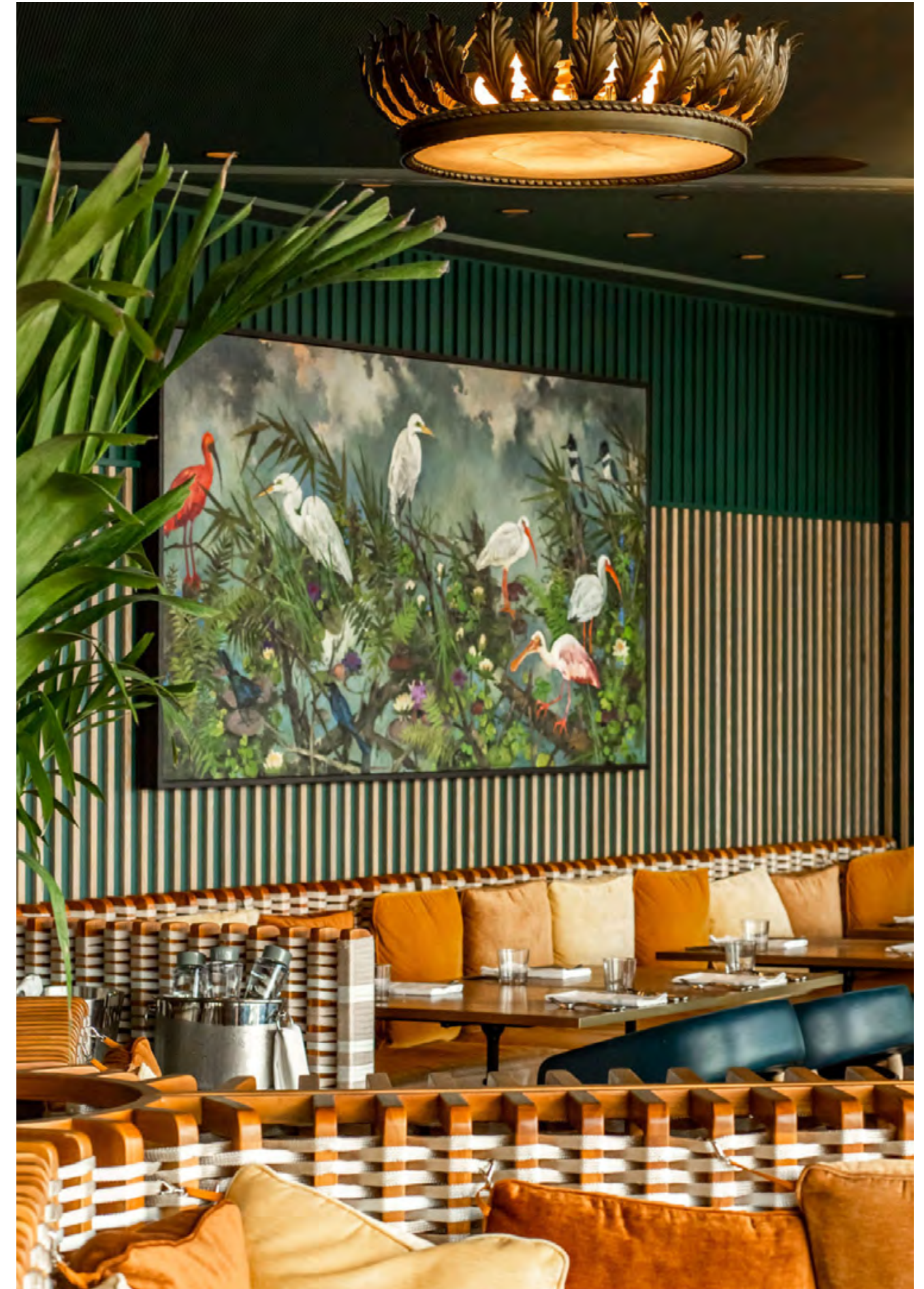
